The Detroit Fintech Challenge is a Fintech competition that unites key players in the Fintech ecosystem to generate enduring solutions to the biggest challenges and major concerns in the financial, payments, banking, and insurance sectors. Through the Fintech Challenge Pitch Competition, early-stage companies will be given a theme/ challenge statement category. Finalists from each "challenge statement category" will be asked to present their concept as a part of the Fintech Challenge Pitch Competition during the Detroit Fintech Challenge weekend.



WHO WE ARE

FinTech is changing the financial sector. Detroit FinTech Challenge aims to break down the barriers to innovation in the financial sector and help to reinvent tomorrow's banking. Anyone who is active in private banking, payment solutions, digital money, blockchains, managing assets, IoT or cyber security are welcome to compete!

WHAT WE DO

The Detroit Fintech Challenge wants to make an economic impact in Michigan by creating new and innovative companies in the financial, banking, insurance, payment solution, and digital money industries. Our goal is to create a community of entrepreneurs and developers working on REAL problems, and creating REAL modular solutions that can eventually be monetized. The Detroit Fintech Challenge will serve as a catalyst to drive a community in Detroit around Fintech Technologies, and engage all the stakeholders in this space.

THE PROCESS

- 1. Collaborate with our sponsors and partners to develop and define 8-10 problems (challenge statements) that need solutions.
- 2. The financial technology company, Yantra, will curate the datasets needed to solve those problems. Yantra is sharing their software and API for developers to create different modules and solutions that can solve problems for companies that would largely benefit from Fintech solutions—including (but not limited to):
 - ✓ Banks
 - Health and Auto insurance
 - ✓ Investment
 - Real Estate

We are seeking corporate partners willing to collaborate by sharing their problems and providing the financial support needed to create investable ideas that we can accelerate into companies.

CHALLENGE STATEMENTS

The Challenge Statements are the guiding force of the Detroit Fintech Challenge. Each and every participating team will choose one or more challenge statements to create their projects. Each statement addresses a broad area of concern as well as a few possible entry points for a technical solution. Teams' effectiveness in creating a viable solution in the challenge they have chosen will be essential to their success in the competition.



Example Challenge Statements:

- 1. Next Generation Payments & Money Transfer: Tools that enable merchants and customers to make payments in new ways. Any product that meets the need for cheaper, faster and easier payments processing has will show immense potential (particularly engaging and activating underserved and underbanked populations).
- 2. Blockchain: Applications of blockchain to a variety of FI problems distributed ledger, cross-border payments, etc.
- 3. Wealth Tech: Solutions that enable the provision of wealth management / investment services in new ways (e.g. robo advice)
- 4. Data / Credit Analytics: Tools to enable analysis of large data sets, often unstructured.
- 5. Cyber Security and Biometrics: IT security solutions against cyber-attacks as well as biometric access solution
